



01 Fragmentation

In the European technology ecosystem there is a lack of reference points. Maintainers are isolated and companies and communities are not cohesive. Much regulation, but little concrete action..

02 No vision and awareness

Companies do not perceive the return on investment (ROI) from using and contributing to open-source software. There is still a misconception that open source software is free.

03 Security and supply chain

Companies do not have full control over private software, which puts them at risk of vendor lock-in. In addition, they lack visibility into the lifecycle and dependencies of open projects.

Current situation



Market cap

In 2025 it is estimated at between 40 and 50 billion dollars. Forecasts say that by 2030 it will be worth about 80 billion.


How Europe is taking action


Our mission

We envision a world where technology serves as a means, grounded in freedom, to help build a more just and equitable society


